

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

We believe that the sole purpose of Hardy County Schools is the education of the enrolled student body. The operation of the schools is a direct responsibility of the Board, acting as a corporate body, and the Superintendent, acting as its executive secretary. The State of West Virginia and the citizens of Hardy County delegate this responsibility to the Board. Consequently, even though the Board members are state officers, they are directly responsible to the citizens of Hardy County for their actions.

The Board has three primary functions: policy-making, legislation, and evaluation. The Board's competence in performing these functions will greatly influence its effectiveness. In addition to its primary responsibilities, the Board attempts to keep the public informed of the purpose, value, conditions, and needs of education in the county; and cooperates with other agencies both public and private, which are interested in the improvement of education and the democratic way of life.
