

BOARD COMMITTEES

Most authorities agree that a Board should operate without standing committees. Consequently, it shall be a practice of the Board to avoid the establishment of permanent standing committees.

Special committees that are assigned a particular task, and dissolved when that task is completed, can contribute much to the Board's performance, and will be utilized as needed. When so created, such committees shall be appointed by the President and shall terminate upon completing their assignments, or they may be terminated by a vote of the Board at any time. Reports and recommendations of special committees can only become official when adopted by the Board in legal session.
