

## CONSULTANTS

From time to time the Board may contract with outside consultants who possess the necessary expertise to provide guidance and suggest alternative solutions to specific needs, which the Board has identified. The assistance sought may include, but not necessarily be limited to:

- (1) Broad, preliminary fact-finding procedures;
- (2) Guidance in collecting, synthesizing, and analyzing data for use by the Board or advisory committee;
- (3) Conducting school surveys;
- (4) Development of technical applications which result in economy of school district resources;
- (5) Recommendation on policy and program in light of wide outside experience;
- (6) Review of plans and proposals prior to Board endorsement; and
- (7) Conducting in-service programs.
