

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS ELIGIBILITY

The supervision and control of Hardy County Schools is under the supervision and control of the five-member county Board. The members of the Board are elected without reference to political party affiliation for a four-year term.

In order to be eligible for board membership the aspirant candidate must be a citizen, a resident of the county, may not be an employee of the county school system, an elected or appointed member of any political party executive committee, or a candidate for any other office.

Any person elected or appointed shall meet all eligibility stipulations regarding educational level, orientation, and training.

Any vacancy, which shall occur in the membership of a Board more than 42 days prior to the next primary, or general election, shall be filled by appointment of the Board. The appointed member shall fill the position until the next primary or general election at which time the voters shall elect a successor to fill the unexpired term. If the Board does not fill the vacancy the State Superintendent of Schools shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy.
