

SCHOOL BOARD POLICY ADOPTION

Proposed policies, rules, regulations, and operation procedures may be presented to the Board at any regular board meeting by any board employee, parent, student, or citizen. The Superintendent shall be responsible for reviewing the board's policies on a regular basis and for drafting new and revised policies, rules, regulations, and operating procedures for the Board's consideration. The Superintendent may select and convene such committees with Board approval of employees, parents, students, or citizens as he deems appropriate to review, revise, or propose policies, rules, regulations, or operating procedures to the Board.

Policies, rules, regulations, and operating procedures recommended to the Board shall not be adopted until a subsequent meeting. During this period, copies of the proposed policies shall be posted in the schools for comment. In this manner the Board shall be provided the opportunity to reflect upon proposed changes and give opportunity for interested parties to have input into policies changes. In emergency cases, the Board may also temporarily suspend a policy, rule, regulation, or operating procedure.

The Superintendent is directed by the Board to establish and maintain an orderly plan for preserving and making accessible the policies, regulations, and operating procedures adopted by the Board.
