

PRINCIPAL'S RESPONSIBILITY

The Principal is assigned primary responsibility for their school.

The Principal, under the direction of the Superintendent, is charged with the administration, supervision, and operation of the individual school program. It is the Principal's responsibility to see that the school functions within the framework of directives of the Superintendent, the policies and regulations of the Board, and the State Board of Education.

The Principal is expected to:

Provide leadership to the staff and assist in interpreting the educational program in the community;

Respond to concerns expressed by parents;

Involve the community in planning and problem solving for their school;

Maintain their yearly budget and control and expend funds allocated to the school;

The Principal must have successfully served as a teacher, have demonstrated administrative ability, and satisfied the educational requirements for the position.
