

TENURE OF EMPLOYMENT

All new personnel, both professional and service employees, will be employed on probationary contracts, and no permanent tenure contract will be granted until said employee shall have held and executed three probationary contracts, each of which was granted for one school year period. Then, tenure is only for employment, not position.

Tenure contracts will be awarded to professional personnel who meet the above requirements, hold a professional certificate based upon a bachelor's degree, have completed a beginning educator internship, and are recommended by the Superintendent.

Both professional and service employees who hold continuing contract status with one county will be granted continuing contract status with any other county upon completion of one year of acceptable employment if such employment is during the next succeeding school year or immediately following an approved Leave of Absence extending no more than one year.
