

W O R K -B A S E D L E A R N I N G P O L I C Y

Purpose:

In accordance with West Virginia State Board of Education Policy 2510, Hardy County students in grades 9-12 will be provided work-based learning experiences. Work-based learning experiences must have the demonstrated ability to assist the student in attaining the Process/Workplace Objectives as defined in West Virginia State Board of Education Policy 2520.

Requirement:

Each student in Hardy County will be required to complete a minimum of one (1) day of job shadowing during their secondary education program. Additionally, students will be offered elective work-based offerings. The work-based learning experience shall be related to the students' career cluster and/or career major. It is not required that the work-based learning experience occurs during the regular school day or within the school calendar.

Procedures:

Refer to the Hardy County Work-Based Learning Procedural Handbook.

Effective Date:

This policy shall be in effect for grades 9-12 for students entering grade 9 in the 2000-2001 school year.
