

HONOR ROLL

Any student earning an overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 in grades 5-12, in the regular academic program, during a marking period shall be placed on the honor roll at his or her respective school.

Any student earning a GPA of at least 3.8, in the regular academic program during a marking period shall be placed on the "Superior Academic Achievement" list at his or her respective school. Grade point average shall be computed according to the following scale: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, and F=0. Honors course grades are computed on the basis of A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, F=0.

Students not in the regular academic program (PMI, TMI, EMI, and LD subjects when grades are given by the LD teacher) who achieve 3.0 or better shall be identified as "Others Receiving Recognition".

It shall be the responsibility of each school principal or his/her designee to determine which students are eligible for the honor roll and to have the list of students published in the local newspaper. This list should be prepared and submitted for publication as soon as possible after the end of the marking period.
