

ADMISSION OF HOME SCHOOL
AND PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS

Students previously enrolled in home schools or private schools may apply for admission to the public schools of Hardy County. Parents are to contact the County Attendance Director who will provide an application and discuss the scheduling of a placement meeting. Additional time must be allowed if application is made during summer months. Such admission shall be made upon meeting the following requirements:

Enrollment Requirements:

1. Satisfactorily meet all residency requirements;
2. Satisfactory completion of all birth, immunization, and health requirements;
3. Satisfactorily meet all academic requirements.

Academic Requirements:

1. Students previously enrolled in home schools or private schools located in West Virginia, that operate under Exemption A, shall be considered for grade level placement based upon the recommendation of the home school or private school and verified by the school principal.
2. Students previously enrolled in home schools located within West Virginia that operate under "Exemption Ba" and Exemption "Bb" shall have appropriate grade level placement determined by the educational staff of Hardy County Schools. This determination may include review of home school/private school achievement records, administering academic assessments determined by the school staff and interviews with the students and/or parents.
3. Students previously enrolled in home schools or private schools located outside of Hardy County, or receiving an education through any other legal exemption shall have appropriate grade level placement determined by the educational staff of Hardy County Schools. This determination may include review of home school or private school achievement records, administering academic achievement measurements, and interviews with the student and/or parents.
