

W O R K P E R M I T S

No child under sixteen years of age shall be employed or permitted to work in any gainful occupation, except agriculture horticulture, or domestic service, unless the person, firm or corporation by whom such child is employed or permitted to work, obtains and keeps on file a work permit issued by the Superintendent of Schools of the county in which such child resides.

The Superintendent of Schools, or his/her designee, shall issue such work permit only upon receipt of the following documents:

1. A written statement, signed by the person from whom the child expects to work, that he intends legally to employ such child.
2. A birth certificate.
3. A certificate signed by the principal or a teacher of the school last attended showing that the child is attending school.

Information about work permits and the proper forms may be obtained at the Superintendent's office.
