

PERMISSION FOR LEAVING SCHOOL

The Board is responsible for the supervision of students from the time they board the school bus or arrive on school property by other transportation in the morning until they get off the school bus or leave school by other transportation in the evening. Students shall not leave school property without proper permission as provided by this policy.

General Provisions

Once a student boards a Hardy County school bus or arrives on school property he/she must have permission to leave school. Students over 18 years of age may leave school without permission of their parent or guardian. All students must follow the sign-out procedures established by each school. Generally students under 18 years of age will not be released to leave school without permission of their parent or guardian. In most cases this permission should be in writing, although the Principal may allow telephone verification if in his/her best judgment the request is legitimate. Parents and guardians may pick up their children at school in person without written verification.

Student Activities

Students who participate in off-campus student activities that are not directly supervised by a teacher shall receive written permission by the parent or guardian verified by the Principal prior to leaving school.
