

ACCIDENTS AND INJURY

In emergency situations, principals, school staff, and teachers may be called upon to handle accidents or injury, medical issues, and provide medication.

Emergency first aid may be provided to prevent death and/or serious hazard to the health of a student from injury of medical emergency.

When necessary the emergency services may be called to transport the student to the hospital or medical facility and/or to provide additional first aid treatment.

If a student is injured and requires first aid from school personnel and/or requires additional medical service, the parents/legal guardian or their designee must be contacted to gain any pertinent information and notified of the actions taken or that may be taken. If it is not possible to contact and notify the parents/legal guardian, the principal or designee shall take the necessary steps to insure that the student receives adequate care.
