

4-H PROGRAM

The Board has recognized in its philosophy that student achievement goes beyond the classrooms. A vital part of the educational program in Hardy County is the 4-H Program which is a cooperative venture between the Hardy County Board of Education and the West Virginia University Cooperative Extension Service.

Funds toward the employment of a county 4-H Agent may be furnished by the Board of Education under a memorandum of understanding which may be annually negotiated between the Board of Education and the County Extension Service Committee and the Hardy County Commission. The Board may provide additional assistance, in-kind contributions, and fiscal support as it may deem appropriate.

The 4-H Agent shall be under the supervision of the West Virginia University Cooperative Extension Service.
